MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE

Respected Delegate,

Greetings from Scientific Committee, EIZOC !

This is the first time that we have decided to have a Scientific Committee for the academic activities of EIZOC. This Committee comprised of two selected members from the 5 larger states and one selected member from the 7 smaller states. The selection of these members has been done by the Managing Committee in discussion with the Hon. Secretaries of the individual state Ophthalmological Societies of the Eastern Zone.

The function of the Scientific Committee will be two-fold. The first and primary function is to prepare the Scientific Program for the Annual and the Mid-term Conferences to be held every year. The second additional function has been envisioned to have at least two scientific clinical meetings annually in each individual state under the banner of EIZOC. The selected Scientific Committee members from each state should be having the responsibility of holding these clinical meetings in their own respective states. Ideally speaking, these clinical meetings can have speakers from the other sister states of our zone in order to create a zonal bonding of the members.

In this digital age of the 20th century, the EIZOC Scientific Committee has also decided to go digital with its Scientific Programs. We propose to have one hour long discussion on various specific ophthalmological topics every alternate Sunday morning in a pre-fixed time convenient to the majority of the members. These topics will be decided by the Sub-speciality Groups. To enable this procedure we decided to create Sub-speciality Groups at the zonal level comprising of our members only. These discussions will be performed in the pre-existing or newly created WhatsApp groups as would be deemed convenient at that point of time. The Sub-speciality Groups proposed are : Cataract, Glaucoma, Cornea, Retina, Strabismus, Oculoplasty, Uveitis, Oncology and Ocular Surface Disorders.

We invite proposals & thoughts for further Scientific activities in future which will enable us to bond with all members of East Zone and create a harmonious relationship together.
